

In order for the Fountain City Classic Parade to be successful, all participants are required to adhere to the following guidelines:

1. In order to be lined up properly by the **FCC Parade Personnel**, all parade participants must be at their designated staging area by **7:00 am**.
2. One parade entry permit, per walking unit, per vehicle or motorcycle. Only participants with a parade permit will be allowed to enter parade line up area. Please be prepared to present parade permit upon request of FCC Parade Personnel.
3. **Parade participants/vehicles** with parade permit should lineup in numerical order according to parade permit number.
4. **Parade permits** should be displayed in the front windshield or prominently on the driver's side of a vehicle. All walking and band units should be able to provide the parade permit. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** A parade permit is required for every unit, vehicle or motorcycle. This is **STRICTLY ENFORCED!**
5. **Parade permits** CANNOT be duplicated or transferred. The entity listed for the permit **MUST** be the one participating in the parade. No Permit Sharing.
6. The parade is a family-friendly event so no vulgar/offensive language or signage will be tolerated.
7. Bus parking is at the Dillingham Amphitheater. Please use the Dillingham Bridge access road to park in the Amphitheater. As you enter into this area please adhere to the FCC Parade Personnel for parking instructions.
8. All cars and floats should be **fully decorated** with display signs on both sides stating the name of the organization.
9. **Phenix City and Columbus Public Safety** will patrol all areas of the parade.
10. **FCC Parade Personnel** are assigned to each section to ensure that these instructions are followed. **All participants MUST follow the directives of the FCC Parade Personnel.**
11. **KEEP MOVING!** No stoppages are allowed in the parade.
12. **ALL VEHICLES DOORS MUST REMAIN CLOSED.**

13. **Disbanding** – The parade ends at the intersection of Broadway and 9th Street. Once you reach this intersection, please **follow the direction of the Columbus Police Department**. Keep moving to avoid causing any stoppages in the parade. If your group needs to gather at the end of parade, please do so on one of the side streets and NOT on 9th Street or Front Avenue. If you need to adjust anything on your vehicle prior to departing, please do so in an area OUTSIDE of the parade route and end of parade staging area.

We hope you have a great time and enjoy your experience, but most of all be safe, and courteous to each other.

Participating in the parade means acceptance of all of these guidelines. Violation to the guidelines or FCC Parade Personnel direction on parade day, can result in immediate removal from the parade. No refunds will be given in the event a unit breaks a parade policy or neglects to follow instructions provided by FCC Parade Personnel.
